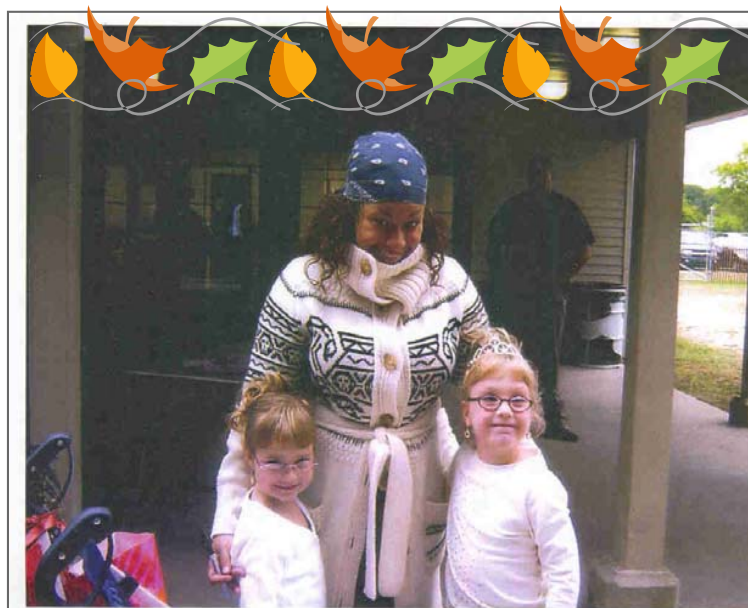
THE IMPOSSIBLE DREAM GALA
